Feeding chillis

Mix up the Chilli Focus at the rates recommended on the label.

Plants can be fed from the seedling stage onwards. The recommendation is to feed weekly but this can be increased as needed. As long as foliage is dark green then feeding is adequate but if it becomes pale then feeding can be increased.

Increase frequency of feeding rather than feed strength. Plants can be fed up to three or four times per week without problems.
